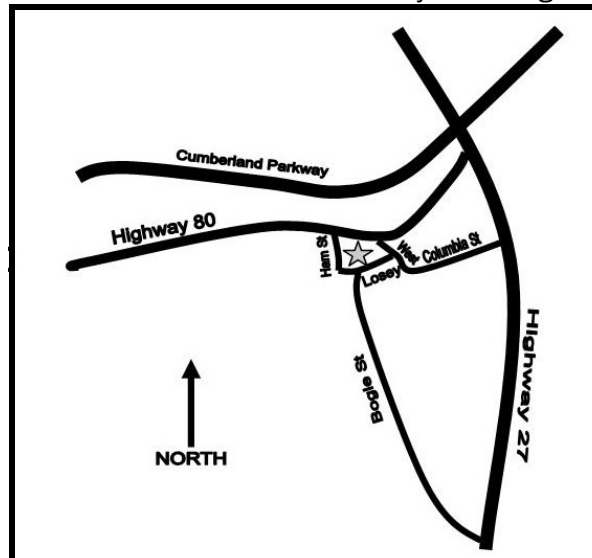


*We provide students and their families many opportunities for Christ-centered fellowship to encourage them in their Christian walk.*

# How to find Us...

**From Hwy 27 North:** Go west on Hwy 80. Turn left approximately 1/2 mile down Hwy 80 onto Ham St. At the stop sign turn left onto Losey St. Grace is on the left.

**From Hwy 27 South:** Turn west onto Bogle St at light number 10. Go straight through the 4-way stop. Bogle will dead end into Losey St. Turn left and Grace is immediately on the right.



**Note:** The youth facility is located in the bottom of the brick building directly across Losey St from the church.

At Grace Baptist Church, our student ministry doesn't just focus on teens. Yes, of course, we provide sound, relevant teaching to students in a safe, cool environment for teens. But our student ministry, in conjunction with the children's ministry and our various adult ministries, seeks to minister to the *entire family*. Our goal is to **M. E. E. ## Weekly Ministries...

### Oasis

Each Wednesday night at 6:30 students grades 7-12 gather in our youth facility to hang out and worship. Our student praise band leads worship and speakers teach relevant Bible study geared towards the needs of teens. In addition, there's free food, games, a coffee house, and other fun and exciting new things each week!

### Small Group Bible Study

On Sunday mornings at 9:00 students have the opportunity to be a part of a small group for in depth Bible study, prayer, accountability, and fellowship. The morning begins in the coffee house with free pastries and fellowship. We then break into our small groups.

**What do we study?** In 7th-8th grade, students do a chronological study of the Bible to learn the overall story of God's Word and how it applies to their everyday life. In 9th-10th, grade students will take part in an organized study of the theology of the Bible, learning not only what they believe, but why they believe it. In 11th-12th grade, students do an in-depth study of the Christian worldview, other religions, and how to defend their faith.

## SOMA Leadership

Our ministry offers students many opportunities to be involved in leadership. Our desire is to equip students to not only survive life after high school, but to thrive as leaders in our world for Jesus Christ. Soma has both leadership teams and ministry teams that students can be a part of along with their parents and other godly adults.



## Other Ministries and Activities...

Our ministry to students also includes other special events that families can plug in to. Some of these include Student Life Camp, Disciple Now, family game nights, family mission trips, and family fellowship events. Each of these events serve to provide students and their families opportunities to grow in Christ, fellowship with one another, and take the Gospel to those in need of Jesus Christ.
